NetSetGo (6 - 10 Years)

NetSetGo is Netball Australia's official starter netball program. Open to **both girls and boys**, it provides children with a positive introduction to netball, incorporating skill activities, minor games and modified matches. There are three levels of the program:

Net – for players aged 5 and 6 Set – for players aged 6, 7 and 8 Go – players aged 9 and 10

At Lindfield Netball Club, we offer Set and Go. Registrations open each year in January and usually close early-March. You may register your child to play online through the Lindfield Netball Club website. "Set"

Players who are turning 6, 7 or 8 in the year of play, and are also in at least Year 1 at school, can register for the "Set" program. Teams are formed based on age and experience; and where possible we try to make sure each child has at least one friend in the team.

Games

- 4 x 10 minute quarters
- Saturday mornings from late March through to late August at Lofberg Rd Netball Courts, West Pymble. There
 are no games in the school holidays.
- Games are scheduled on the hour from 8am 1pm, and teams play at the same time each week. KNA
 advises the playing times once teams are formed and competitions of similar age and experience can be
 created.

Training

- Club Coaching support is on hand to assist our Parent Coaches.

"Go"

Players who are turning 9 or 10 in the year of play can register for the "Go" program. Teams are formed through a grading process, which matches up players who are at a similar stage in their skill development. *These are not friendship based teams*.

Games

- 4 x 10 minute quarters
- U9 Thursday evenings (5pm & 6pm) late March through to late August at Canoon Rd Netball Courts, South Turramurra. There are no games in the school holidays.
- U10 Saturday mornings (8am) late March through to late August at Canoon Rd Netball Courts, South Turramurra. There are no games in the school holidays.

Position Rotations

<u>KNA has a position rotation policy for U6 –U8 that each team **must** follow. This ensures all players have equal time in each position and are able to actively learn all areas of the court.
